Fact: Renting deprives you of large tax breaks.

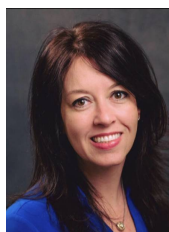
Fact: A home is a leveraged investment using other peoples' money.
